

## ICANN 52 Enhanced By Bosch Systems

**SINGAPORE:** The Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers (ICANN) recently held its 52nd Public Meeting at the Raffles City Convention Centre in Singapore, from February 9th to 12th.

ICANN aims to ensure a stable, secure and unified global Internet. In keeping with the organisation's mission, ICANN 52 brought together stakeholders from around the world to discuss what the future of the internet may look like, in light of last year's announcement that the United States (U.S.) government will transition stewardship of the Internet Assigned Numbers Authority (IANA) functions to the global multi-stakeholder community. The meeting also aimed to present the various proposed changes to the public and gain feedback from Internet users around the world.
